Docks: multiple – and will be positioned for greatest flexibility and ease of loading

Water Quality: healthy quality and tested by the Fayette County Water System; the lake is part of an

overall water system which feeds into the water supply for Fayette County

Avg Temp: September average temperatures are a low of 60 and a high of 85



COMPETITION FORMAT

The Peachtree City Dragon Boat Race & International Festival will be produced by PanAm Dragon Boat who will supply 8 small (10-paddler) boats including PFDs (flotation jackets) and paddles.

You are welcome to bring your own IDBF Licensed Paddle showing the Spec 202a Manufacturers Mark. Maximum paddle length is 51 inches.

Our Festival insurance requires ALL paddlers, steers, and drummers to wear a US Coast Guard-approved personal flotation device (PFD).

PanAm will also provide all the race officials and professional steers. All Recreational teams are required to use a PanAm steer. Competitive teams are permitted to use their own team steer unless they are causing a race disruption or are deemed to be unsafe by the PanAm staff, in which case, a PanAm steer will be provided at no extra charge to that team.

The racing program will be determined by the makeup of the registered teams. All teams will race 2 qualifying heats and 1 final race. There are further opportunities to register for Fastest Time of the Day trophies. The winner of the Knock-Out race will have their 2026 team fees waived (a \$700 value).

Medals for 1st-3rd place in each race category/group will be awarded at the end of the day after the Knock Out race. Medals for the RCC Special Needs teams will be awarded directly after their lunchtime exhibition race.

Free Agent paddlers are available to help teams who are short paddlers to be able to fill their rosters. In addition, when there are enough Free Agent paddlers registered, the Festival will create a separate team for them to race in the appropriate category.

FASTEST TIME OF THE DAY TROPHY

During the team registration process, an additional \$100 (or \$50 for non-profits) will purchase the right to be included with other teams in recording who had the fastest time of the day in each of these categories:

"BEST OF THE BEST" KNOCK-OUT RACE

This race is brand new to Peachtree City and its inclusion this year is a testament to the high-quality competitiveness of teams that we attract. The winner of this race will have their team fees waived for 2026. This is a \$750 value!

During the team registration process, an additional \$100 will purchase your entry to this race. It is currently capped at 6 team entries.

How a Knock-Out Race works:

- 1. Six teams line up at the 100m mark and race to the finish line.
- 2. The slowest two boats are knocked out and head back to marshaling.
- 3. The remaining four boats go immediately to the 100m mark to run the race again.
- 4. The slowest boat is knocked out and heads back to marshaling.
- 5. The remaining three boats to immediately to the 100m mark to run the race a final time.
- 6. The winner of this race will have their 2026 team fees waived!

CANCER SURVIVORS

Breast cancer and all-cancer survivor crews (BCP/ACP) are dragon boat crews formed from competitors who have been diagnosed with breast cancer or another form of cancer.

Team Captains, please be sure to indicate that your team should be considered as an BCP/ACP crew during the registration process. We will be featuring a Flower Ceremony to recognize you.

Everyone on the roster of a team registered in the ACP division must be a cancer survivor. For BCP teams, everyone on the roster must be a breast cancer survivor.

In both divisions, these rules do not apply to the drummer or the steer.

PARADRAGONS

The Para-dragon category is relatively new to our sport and gaining lots of traction. We are proud to announce that the leadership team of the Peachtree City Dragon Boat Race & International Festival has been on the leading edge of including this category of paddlers for the past 14 years for our Special Needs community, as well as in the past 3 years with our PD3 paddlers who all have a lower limb amputation.

We are strongly committed to our continuing encouragement of those paddlers with physical, psychological, neurological, sensory, developmental or intellectual impairments to participate at the club and local festival level so that interested Para-dragon individuals and teams are prepared to participate on the National and International stages when the opportunity arises for them.

HOW TO BOOK A TEAM PRACTICE

Each team's registration fee includes one coached practice session which will be held at the event site, on Friday, September 26th. Registration fees must be received in full and confirmed before the practices may be booked. TEAM / VENDOR / SPONSOR TENT RULES

The City of Peachtree City does not allow ANY STAKING on Drake Field due to underground utilities that could be damaged. To ensure compliance with this rule, the Festival will provide each team a tented 10x10 space in the Athlete's Village which is included in the team fees.

Teams should NOT bring their own tents, and are strongly encouraged instead to bring their own chairs and to decorate the 10x10 space allotted to them.

All vendor and sponsor tents will be required to use weights to keep their tent secured rather than stakes.
