



Vendor Options / Guidelines

Please consider becoming a vendor for the Annual Peachtree City Dragon Race & International Festival. The information below provides guidelines, general information and vendor levels. Consideration will be given to provide reasonable opportunities for each vendor to avoid duplications and allow for several unique products.

Please note: This even will run rain or shine. No refunds will be given.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. Location: Drake Field, Lake Peachtree, 155 Willowbend, Peachtree City, GA.
2. Booth / Tent Space allowed is 10 ft x 10 ft. Vendors are responsible for providing their own set up / displays (such as canopies, tables, chairs, shelving, easels, grills, etc.) unless otherwise noted on the vendor's application.
3. Food vendors must comply with all Peachtree City Fire permit / regulation requirements, and Fayette County Department of Environmental Health requirements (links can be found on website).
4. Canopies for the booth space will be on grass. Vendors are responsible for securing these appropriately with bags and/or weights (**stakes are ABSOLUTELY not permitted**).
5. Electricity will only be available for your booth if requested and noted on the acceptance of your vendor application. These will be distributed on a first-come, first-serve basis. Vendors will be responsible for their own extension cords. If you have a heavy-draw appliance, it is strongly recommended to bring personal generators.

SET-UP / TEARDOWN:

1. Vehicles will not be allowed on Drake Field, or in the natural areas surrounding the field. Hand trucks and carts must be used on paved paths to transport items for Vendor setup to minimize damage to vegetation.
2. Please make the necessary arrangements to allow enough time to set up before 7:30 am as the drop-off area will be closed at that time for shuttles only.
3. Vendors will need to check-in with the event team prior to setup. Booth assignments, parking passes, and additional vendor information will be provided one week prior to the event.
4. Setup will be available on Friday between 4 pm and 8 pm and again on Saturday from 6 am to 7:30 am.
5. Booths should be operational from 9 am to 4 pm on the day of the event. You may also choose to open as early as 8 am for the race teams / opening ceremonies.
6. Booth teardown may not begin until after closing ceremonies (4 pm) on Saturday. All booths must be cleared out by 6:30 pm.
7. Vendors are responsible for cleaning up their booth area following the event.
8. Grease **MUST** be taken off premises for appropriate disposal.

VENDOR LEVELS:

1. Food / Vendor Trucks - \$300
2. Food / Vendor /Info Booth - \$100

*All vendors will be recognized on event media and by race announcer on the day of the event.
